The songs give the player a chance to put his or her personal stamp on the melody as well as on the solo sections. Score includes both B-flat and E-flat parts. Includes a high-quality printed music score with parts for both B-flat tenor and E-flat alto saxes, and a compact disc containing a complete performance with soloist (on tenor sax); then a second version with accompaniment only.

An indispensable collection of sixty progressive studies for unaccompanied saxophone, suitable for E flat and B flat instruments. The book systematically covers aspects of technique, in order of difficulty from Grades 1 to 8, while being carefully paced to provide lots of material at each level.

Chop-Monster is a sequential jazz improvisation method by acclaimed jazz pianist and educator Shelly Berg that utilizes a "call-and-response" approach: students listen to a jazz idea, imitate it until it is internalized, and then "try it on their own." In Chop-Monster 1, students will hear and improvise to the Ima7, iimi7, and V7 chords in the key of B-flat, plus a basic blues progression. In Chop-Monster 2 students will hear and improvise to the ii-V-I progression in three keys (concert B-flat, E-flat, F).
